Having missed out on getting tickets before they sold out, The Snuts sorted us out so we could cover the gig and for that we are very grateful!

First up were Ruvellas. They are up and coming five piece band of 16 year olds who originate from Dundee. It's always good to see a young band, showing that even though mainstream music is full of manufactured pop music there are still kids who want to be in a band. This is something that hopefully never stop happening no matter what the mainstream music situation is and hopefully one day we have bands in the charts again. Anyway back to these lads. They gave a very good and confident set for 16 year olds in front of a busy crowd. Their music is influenced by Oasis and it showed as they sound like early years Oasis- which isn't a bad thing. If anything it would have been good if they were on for longer as they sound great. Really looking forward to their next gig. Well done lads!

Next up were Saint-Louie. We have covered them a few times here at Discovery Music and always it was a pleasure to see these guys do their thing on stage. Having had a chance to listen to them practice in the studio in the run up to the gig, we were buzzing to hear it at the gig and they did not disappoint. A set full of just great guitar tunes, it was superb to see them play to a packed crowd. Even with a recent line up change with a new bass player, these guys continue to go from strength to strength and its been brilliant to follow them since the start. We firmly believe that these guys are one of the best up and coming bands from Dundee and are already looking forward to seeing them again very soon. If you get the chance to see them live then go and see them as you will not be disappointed.

Finally it was time for the headliners The Snuts. For those who don't know, they are a four piece band who hail from Whitburn, West Lothian. They are arguably the best up and coming band on the Scottish indie scene and from last nights performance its clear to see why they sold out their recent Scottish tour. A capacity crowd were bouncing from the start as they kicked off with their song The Matador- the title of their four song EP they released. The highlight of the set was obviously when the band played their massively popular tune Glasgow- this nearly took the roof off the building! The crowd were also treated to a few new songs from the band which were very good as well. Overall a superb performance and it was easy to see why they have such a massive following and getting slots to play at festivals across the UK. 2018 is going to be a massive year for the band and with abit of luck we will be able to see them as much as we can as they are well worth seeing.
